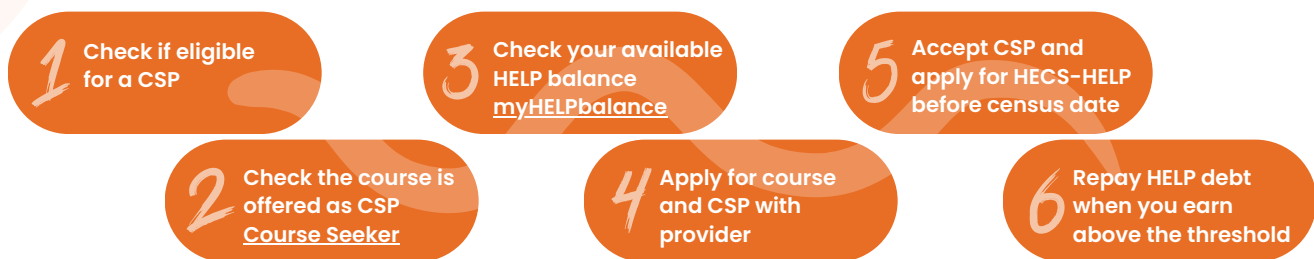


Finances

Course Fees and Payment

Two types of course places

1. **Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP)** – This is subsidised enrolment by the Australian Government. Criteria applies and you are responsible for paying the remaining portion (**student contribution**).



2. **Full Fee Place** – This is a full fee-paying place (not government subsidised) and often post-graduate. For assistance in paying see **FEE-HELP loans**.

Two types of government payment schemes (interest-free)

1. **HECS-HELP Loan** – This loan may allow you to defer paying back a **CSP student contribution**. Repayments occur once your income reaches a threshold.

2. **FEE-HELP Loan** – This loan allows you to defer paying back a Full Fee Place (subject to the provider offering and criteria). Repayments occur once your income reaches a threshold.

Other Fees you may be charged

Student Services and Amenities Fees: These are separate from your unit fees and are charged to all students. They are not part of your accommodation costs. If you are eligible you may be able to defer these fees to the ATO if you complete the Student Amenities (SA-HELP) form.

Accommodation Fees: These are fees charged by the residential colleges for on-campus accommodation and intensive school accommodation. You will need to refer to your contract with the accommodation provider for the terms and conditions payment deadlines.

Miscellaneous Fees: This can include fees for overseas exams or late change of exam venue fees.
