We begin by acknowledging Ngarigo/Ngarigu Country – an important place to many Aboriginal peoples – the birthplace of rivers.

Country in our (Aboriginal) way of understanding things is more than just the dirt under our feet, although that is an important part of Country too. Country is the landscapes (high country, swamplands, mountains, plains, and deserts), the animals (from the microscopic to the colossal), the vegetation (grasses, trees, bushes, vines, and flowers), the rocks (from pebbles to mineral deposits), the waterways (puddles, rivers, creeks, and oceans), the seasons (many more than just four), the weather (the sunshine, winds, storms, and dry periods), and the stories (the ancient through to the contemporary).

In acknowledging Country we assert our reliance on Mother Earth for all things (shelter, sustenance, and beauty to satisfy the soul). We equally affirm our respect for the Elders (experts in their cultural ways and holders of the knowledge and stories that are embedded in this place), for their enduring custodianship.

CUC Snowy Monaro (CUCSM) team members will:

- provide a safe and welcoming space to students who are: graduating from Year 12 in 2024 a resident of the Snowy Monaro Local Government Area completing Year 12 study at any school or through any institution
- provide resources to support study such as fast and reliable WIFI, whiteboards, printing etc
- encourage students to stay study focussed while at the Program
- provide university and other course advice if requested
- introduce and welcome Program students to CUCSM facilities so they are familiar and comfortable studying at the Centre
- support students to create a basic study plan if they do not already if requested

Benefits of the Program include:

- local students have a safe, study focussed facility to ensure students can study with minimal distractions
- students have appropriate, adult supervision who will encourage focussed study
- students become familiar with the services and facilities provided by CUCSM if they choose to pursue further study after completing their schooling
- breaking down barriers to tertiary education for Snowy Monaro community members
- increased retention of tertiary students studying in the Snowy Monaro
- breaking down barriers and establishing relationships between the students and CUCSM team members to ensure a familiar source of support for future study needs
- further development of CUCSM's working relationship with University of Canberra

The Year 12 Exam Prep Program offers local Year 12 students a free, quiet and safe space to study with a CUCSM team member remaining onsite during the scheduled study periods.

We recognise that our local year 12 students may be completing their study in NSW, ACT, another Australian State or an alternate method and welcome any Snowy Monaro resident currently completing Year 12 final exams and assessments to book in to study at CUCSM during the allocated times.

The Program will be located at CUC Snowy Monaro, 38 Bombala Street, Cooma. There may be sessions offered at the Jindabyne Library. The Jindabyne sessions will be promoted on CUC Snowy Monaro's social media platforms.

CUCSM will provide the following for students in Cooma:

- fast WIFI
- study space
- power for plugging in devices
- supervision
 - study related printing
 - whiteboards
- basic snacks, water and hot drinks (cold drinks are available for \$2)

CUCSM will provide the following for students in Jindabyne:

- public WIFI Jindabyne Library
- supervision CUCSM and UC team members
- study space Jindabyne Library
- power for plugging in devices Jindabyne Library
- basic snacks, water and hot drinks

Students attending the Program are responsible for bringing everything else they need to complete their study including their own device.

Subject Specific Tutoring

University of Canberra may provide scheduled subject specific tutoring in Cooma and/or Jindabyne. Further information will be promoted on CUCSM's Facebook and Instagram platforms and the CUCSM website.

STUDENT AGREEMENT

Please read carefully the Year 12 Exam Prep Program Student Agreement.

- Students must use the booking system to schedule their study sessions
- Student must cancel the booking online OR advise CUCSM by text (0437344620) that they will not be attending a booked session or risk being excluded from future sessions
- The Lecture Room will be set up for year 12 students to use and, unless advised by a CUCSM team member, this space will be the only study space available to year 12 students using the Centre
- Students must use the internet appropriately and for study reasons only
- Students must be respectful to CUCSM team members, other year 12 students and other students using the Centre for other study
- CUCSM team members may ask to take photos of year 12 students to use in funding and governance reports, social and print media as well as other purposes. Written consent from parents and guardians is required before photos are taken and used by CUCSM
- inappropriate, offensive, unsociable and deliberately disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in the student being asked to leave
- Some snacks will be provided, but bringing your own food is recommended.
- Students are responsible for cleaning up any mess they make
- CUCSM team members are not responsible for travel to and from CUCSM
- CUCSM team members will not supervise students outside of their scheduled booking time
- Students must complete an information form before or upon arriving at their first booked study session
